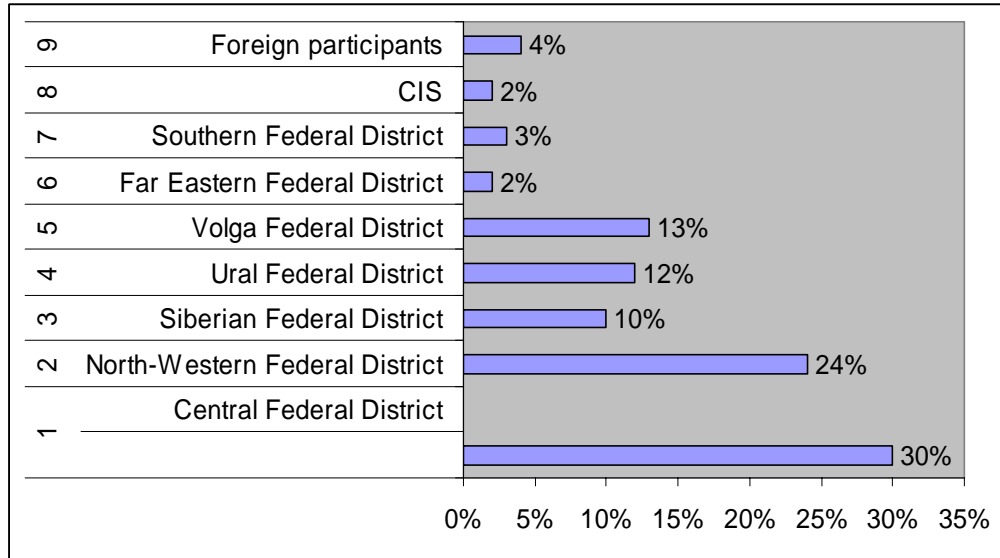

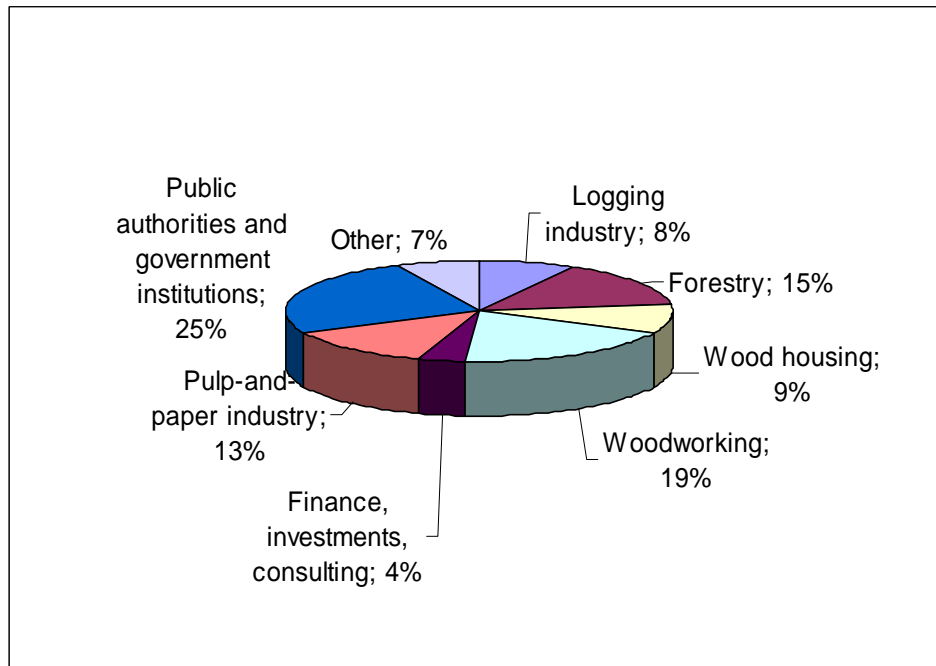

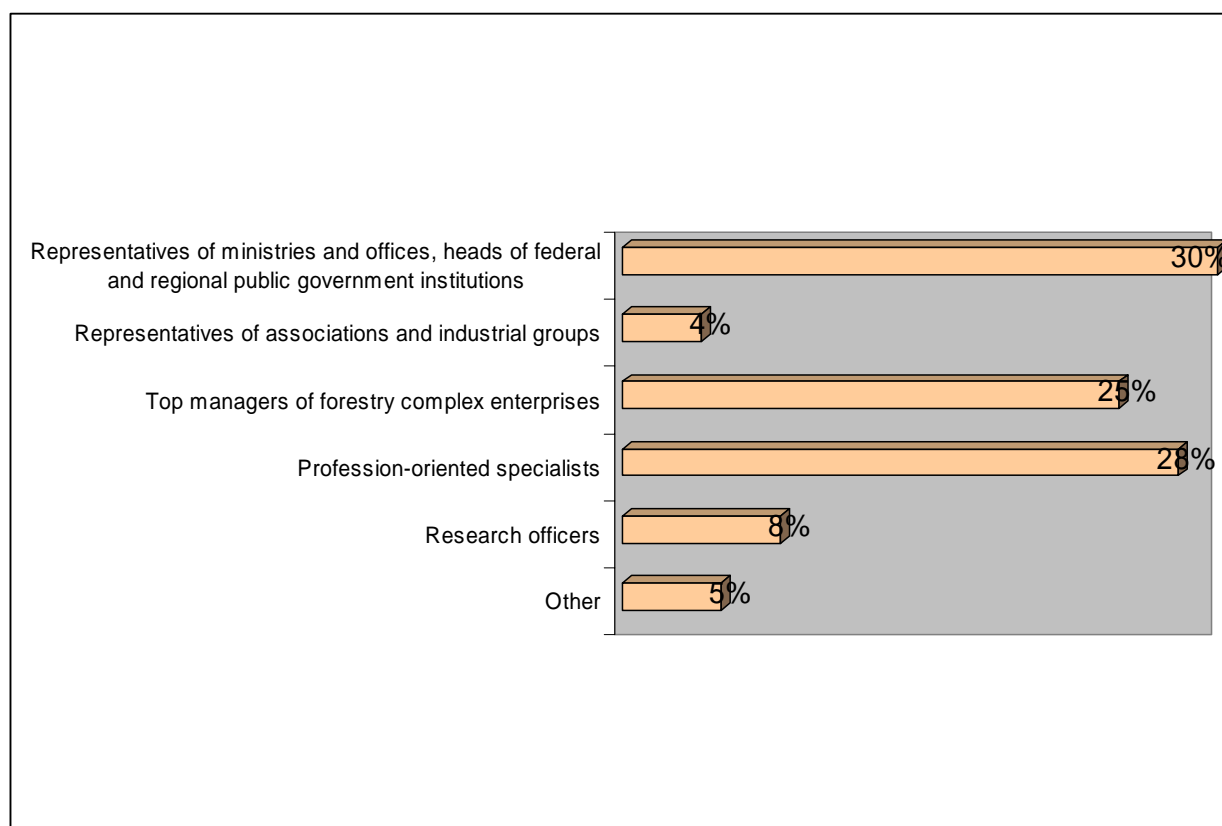
GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF PARTICIPANTS

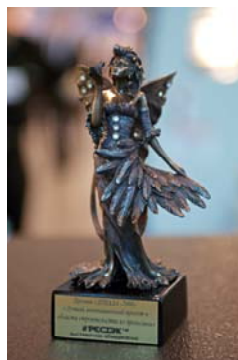

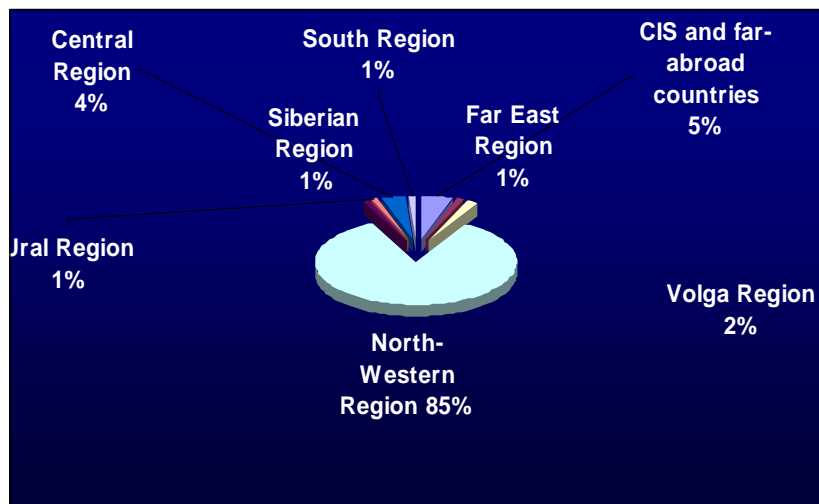
3rd International Exhibition of Technologies, Equipment and Facilities of Pulp-and-Paper Industry

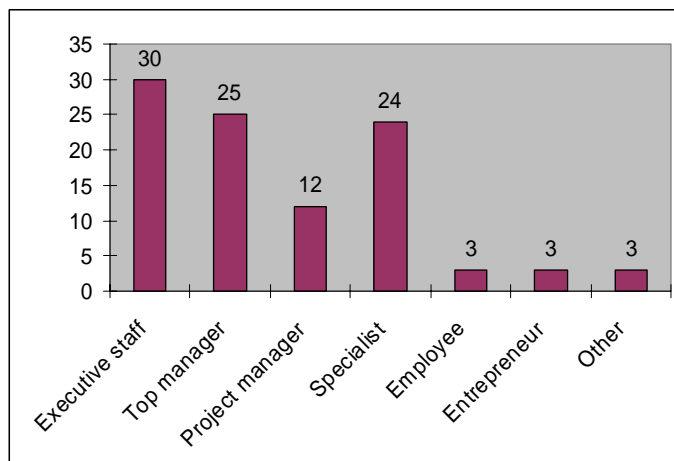

VISITORS OF THE EXHIBITION PROGRAMME

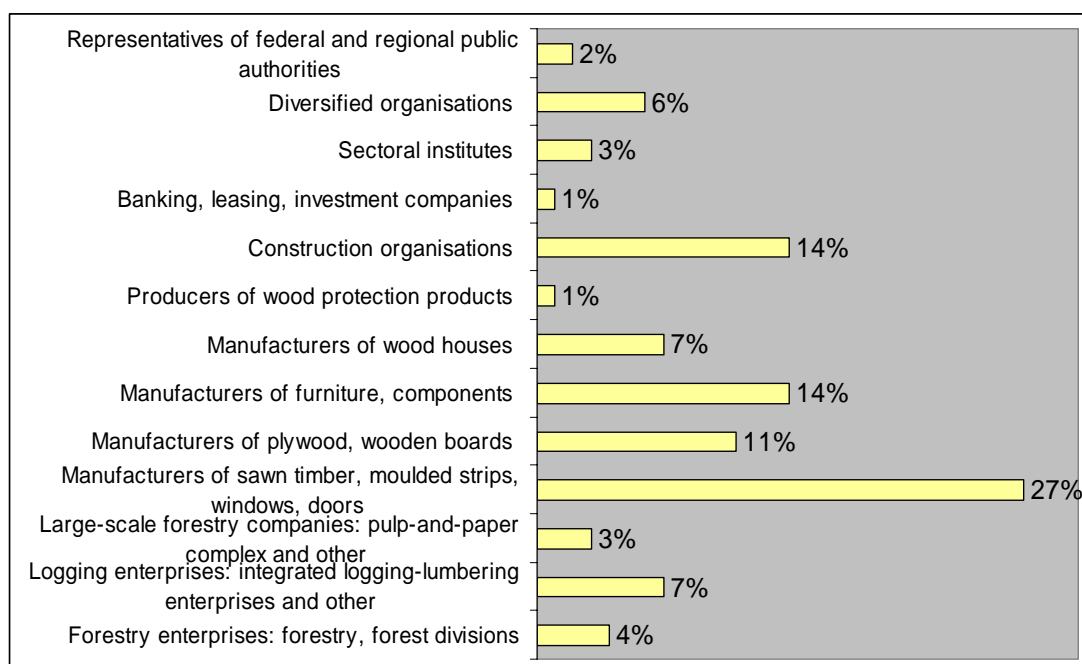

DECLARATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FORESTRY FORUM OCTOBER 4–10, 2008, ST. PETERSBURG

The 10th International Forestry Forum, which took place in St. Petersburg, gathered representatives of forestry sector and forestry complex from all regions of Russia and 37 countries of the world.

The following events took place within the framework of the Forum:

- International workshop conference 'The Role of Forest in Climate Stabilisation: Researches – Innovations – Investments – Human Resources'
- Plenary session 'Russia and the Global Forest Community: New Priorities of Forestry Development'
- Conference 'Wood Housing'
- Conference 'Improvement of Public Forest Management and Forestry Development'
- Conference 'Russian Forestry Infrastructure. Development Prospects and Trends'
- Conference 'Wooden Boards Production'
- IPPTF Conference 'Crucial Issues of the Russian Pulp-and-Paper Industry Development. Trends and Advanced Technologies'
- Conference 'Bioenergy in Russia'
- Business Contacts Exchange

A wide range of questions important for the forest community and forestry business under the circumstances of new forestry legislation development, changing conditions of global and domestic forest goods markets were thoroughly discussed at the events of the Forum. Forestry legislation problems and suggestions of their solving were also considered. There were highlighted prospects for forestry legislation development, law enforcement practice improvement at the federal and regional levels in the industrial and regional policies.

Within the framework of the Forum exhibition program representatives of different segments of the Forestry Complex, producers and consumers of the latest equipment and technologies widened their business contacts.

The international conference 'Forest and Climate' was held with the support of the Federal Forestry Agency of the Russian Federation, World Bank, Food and Agriculture Organisation of the United Nations (FAO UN), International union of forest research organisations, World Meteorological Organisation and other organisations. The conference gathered scientists, forestry experts, forest business representatives from 20 countries of the world to assist in finding mutual understanding, share opinions and discuss prospects for the development of international cooperation mechanisms. It proceeded a set of international meetings devoted to forest and climate problems held under the initiative of the FAO UN in 2008. Such conferences have already taken place in Sweden and China, and the final conference is to be held in Rome at the end of October 2008.

The conference participants noted an important meaning of forests in regulating climate processes on the planet. It was also emphasised that boreal forests play a specific role in climate processes regulating. Irrational exploitation and ineffective forest management in boreal forests will only aggravate negative and even catastrophic consequences of climate changing that can receive global scale.

The conference participants recommend politicians, business and researchers to develop more actively multidiscipline scientific research and assist in receiving new knowledge about forest role in climate mild and stabilisation; to use complex technological and project solutions based on new technologies and innovations; assist in developing of multidiscipline approaches to usage, protection, defence and reproduction of forest resources; to develop systems of monitoring and forecasting of carbon sink changing within forest ecosystems; assist in state and private investment attraction for climate projects realisation and innovation usage in the forest sector; expand forestry sector human and raw materials potential for realisation of policy for mitigation of climate changing consequences.

The Forum participants reviewed with great interest the project of the Forestry Complex development strategy up to 2020 that is being prepared by the working group on the Forestry complex development under the Government of the Russian Federation. The strategy is based on the following key statements determining the forest policy for the prospective in the field of the state forest management improvement: establishment of the state forest service, increase in profitability of forest usage based on the improvement of forest planning and payments administration, expansion of rent spaces meant for deep wood processing, increase in forest reproduction efficiency, reduction of forest growing periods, increase in productivity and forest quality rising, control over the fulfilment of the given powers by the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, state forest inventory and other.

The Forestry Complex development strategy is based on the new economic policy in the forest sector, which suggests rising of the minimal payment rates for forest resources, compensation to the land holder for expenses regarding forest reproduction works and forest roads construction, increase of the minimal payment rates for recreation activity in commercially attractive regions.

At the same time the participants of the International Forestry Forum noted that the Forest sector of the Russian Federation is undergoing the process of establishment an absolutely new system of forest relations. Creation of a new forest management system within the decentralisation cause a number of difficulties at the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, that cannot provide the effective forest management and fully use powers vested in them. Conditions of the preparation procedure and approval of the first-priority investment projects in the field of forest exploitation are not efficient enough for the investment development of the Forestry Complex processing plants.

The following positive shifts in the Russian Forestry complex were mentioned at the Forum: stable growth in production of the main types of woodworking production, considerable flow of investment into the wood processing, development of bioenergetics and wood housing.

During 2008 the situation in pulp-and-paper and woodworking industries has significantly changed under the influence of the enacted new forest legislation. These changes are mainly connected with the rising of activity and influence of the Russian Federation constituent entities administrations, as well as enterprises proprietors designing programs of their expansion and modernisation and potential investors looking for opportunities for creation of new deep wood processing enterprises.

Powers for chipboard and MDF production are created at an outstripping growth rate, new plants are constructed and the present ones are reconstructed. Large specialised western companies gave an impulse for wood processing enterprises development.

The issue of a considerable deficit of high-qualified executive and middle experts practically in all industries of the Forestry Complex was also noted at the Forum. This puts the task of preparation and continuing of education of human resources based on the leading higher education Russian institutions and present enterprises to the main priorities of the sector development.

The following suggestions have been elaborated within the framework of the 10th International Forestry Forum:

1. The Government of the Russian Federation has to speed up the development and adopt the development strategy of the forestry complex of the Russian Federation till 2020 as the main document determining the development of the forest policy for the midterm.
2. To introduce changes and additions to the Forest Code of the Russian Federation, laws and regulations in the field of forest exploitation intensity rising and forestry management; improvement of financial mechanisms regulating forest exploitation; realisation of the priority investment projects in the field of forest exploitation; prevention of the timber illegal sales volume; forest exploitation organisation based on the development of small and medium forest business.
3. To adopt regulatory legal acts determining the order of timber sales volume and state support of small and medium business enterprises.
4. Analyse the present system of forest management in different constituent entities of the Russian Federation and give recommendations based on the most successful projects.
5. To recommend the constituent entities of the Russian Federation to consider the issue concerning preparation of administrative regulations defining forest districts activity as regional bodies for forest management.
6. To prepare recommendations on forest sector investment projects preparation.
7. With the aim of implementation of the Forestry Complex innovation system on human resources preparation and scientific-technological support, it is recommended to create forest research and educational complexes consolidating potential of education, science and business based on the state-private partnership. To develop the program of creation of research and educational complexes, in which it is necessary to define forms, methods of cooperation and integration of research and educational structures.
8. For further development of the Forestry Complex highlighted trends for the economic growth a number of crucial issues must be solved:
 - Implementation of the innovative Forestry Complex development model;
 - Creation of import-substituting productions to answer the demands of the domestic market in pulp-and-paper goods and goods of woodworking with a high VAT;
 - Rising of competitiveness of pulp-and-paper and forest industries production due to increase of their ecological compatibility, reduction of their material and energy consumption, use of secondary fibre and forest waste;
 - Introduction of the best modern technologies in the forestry complex taking into account the international experience in the environmental protection, ecological regulation and control.

9. To enhance consideration and adoption of amendments to the Forest Code of the Russian Federation directing at the stimulation of the long-term investment into the creation of new powers for deep wood.

10. To provide formation of the concrete mechanisms of the state-private partnership necessary for meeting of state and business interests at the priority areas of the innovative development of the economy forest sector, foreseeing the creation of the infrastructure; full or partial exemption of the income tax, property and equipment for the period of new enterprises exploitation; preparation of the necessary scientific and human resources supply.

11. To speed up development and adoption of regulatory documents necessary for a stage-by-stage industry shift to the best available technologies and technological regulation providing the decrease of influence on the environment, energy and resource saving.

12. To develop in the constituent entities of the Russian Federation suggestions regarding the formation of the optimal chain of forest roads, including public ones, taking into account already acting logging and woodworking enterprises, as well as prospects for development of the regional forestry complex.

13. To write additions to the regulatory system defining demands to the forest roads taking into account the parameters of the modern timber trucks (truck's weight, axle load; truck's length, width clearance).

14. To provide creation and realisation of financial mechanism for development and support of scientific research and innovations within the framework of "The Russian forest technological platform", defining the strategic direction of scientific research in the forestry complex till 2030.

15. To create favourable conditions for development of bioenergetics in Russia, production and introduction of advanced technologies on forest waste recycling and disposal.

Forum confirmed it necessary to:

- Adopt immediate measures to eliminate obstacles in wood housing development;
- Enhance the development and legal enforcement of modern mechanisms of ecological regulation in the Forestry Complex, oriented to the best existing technologies;
- Increase of purchase practice of certified forest goods for the state needs;
- Create a national system of the voluntary forest certification;
- Further development of the Forestry Complex legislation system based on the principles stated in the Forest Code of the Russian Federation taking into account the experience accumulated during the process of reforming forest relations in other countries.

International Forestry Forum confirms high efficiency of the chosen format for its organisation and considers it useful to use this format for organisation of the following meetings, congresses and conferences regarding the Forestry Complex.
